

BEING LED BY THE SPIRIT

John 14:16 (KJV) And I will pray the Father, and he shall give you another Comforter, that he may abide with you for ever;

John 16:13 (NASB) "But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, He will guide you into all the truth; for He will not speak on His own initiative, but whatever He hears, He will speak; and He will disclose to you what is to come.

Galatians 5:16 (KJV) This I say then, Walk in the Spirit, and ye shall not fulfil the lust of the flesh.

When you accept Jesus Christ, the Holy Spirit begins to lead and guide you in all truth. Being led by God is like a paper clip on one side of a board being attracted to a magnet on the other side of the board. The thickness of the board (called layers) are things in your life that causes you not to feel the magnetism / guidance. The more a Christian walks in the flesh, the less awareness they feel of the Holy Spirit.

6. What did Jesus say the Counselor (God the Holy Spirit) would do? (John 14:25-26)
